It's here! It's August 10th! It's the 1969 Independent, Free Redio Relly, at Trafalger Square, London.

The rally is being organised by the National Commercial Radio Movement, in conjunction with the Free Radio Campaign: Bristol Free Radio Movement, and any other organisations that wish to join the "United Free Radio Organisations".

We are inviting people who are really interested to help us in the organisation of the rally, by writing to us with a S.A.E. marking the envelope "RALLY HELP".

We have invited speakers from the former off-shore stations a number of M.P.s have been invited, and a letter has been sent to all Radio One d.j.s inviting them to speak. A list of speakers will be issued later, but amongst those people already listed, there will be speakers who are LISTERERS! We consider the listener to be the most important person as far as radio is concerned, because without the listeners, no radio station could operate. There will also be an opportunity for other listeners to ask questions about redio broedcasting.

This is to be the biggest-ever public demonstration for the choice of free, independent redio in this country. It is going to be bigger than the demonstration at Liverpool Street Station on August 14th 1967.

The subjects to be discussed at the rally will the future of broadcasting in this country. This will cover a wide range of topics from the B.B.C.'s re-organisation plans, the Conservative Party's scheme for local radio, availability of frequencies in the future, commercial viability of the various types of staticus.

People are already planning to bring car and mini-bus loads of people into London from pleases such as, Plymouth, Oxford, Leicester, Bristol and many parts of Essay. Scotland are also sending down their representatives to join the biggest free radio crowd, ever.
